Thence 302' ± AZ 157° 45' to a point. Thence 228' ± AZ 159° 42' to Morton Road.

Civil District of Roane County, Tenn. and described as follows: Bordered by Pansy Hill Road on North on South by Morton Road on the East by Mack Cooper and on the West by Albert Cook and Mr. Thomas.

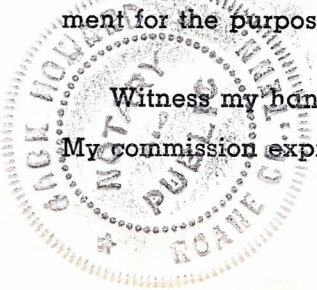
